



Policy: Responsible Use of Torrens Clubhouse Facilities

1. RATIONALE AND PURPOSE

1.1 The Torrens Rowing Club is committed to protecting its historical club house to secure the future of the institution

1.2 The Torrens Rowing Club will provide fair access to members to the Club and considers its prime operations to be a competitive rowing club and community organization

1.3 This policy aims to provide guidance over what is considered responsible use of the Torrens Rowing Club facilities

2. POLICY GUIDELINES

2.1 The Torrens Rowing Club Captain, Vice Captain and Coaches , will make their best endeavours to ensure rowing activities do not interfere with event-use of the Function Room

2.2 The Facilities Manager of the Torrens Rowing Club will make best endeavours to ensure the activities of the Function Room do not interfere with rowing operations or impede the best interest of TRC as a competitive sporting club and community-based organization

2.3 All Rowing Club functions must have a set end-time

2.4 Members may not sleep at, or otherwise inhabit, the Torrens Rowing Club overnight unless during a Committee-sanctioned event (for example a school camp) with appropriate supervision

2.5 Club members may book the room for private functions through the Functions Manager

2.6 Club members must seek approval of the TRC Committee before booking the function room for a Club fundraiser

2.7 Club equipment (including but not exclusive to ladders, trestle tables, marquee, etc) are the property of the Torrens Rowing Club and are not to be used for any purpose than that for which they were purchased by the Club, unless permission is sought from the Captain.
